

## Interdistrict Transfer of Resident Students

Interdistrict transfers for resident students requesting to transfer out of the district will be granted only when the request meets established parameters.

The district discourages unnecessary interdistrict transfer; however, acknowledges that emergencies and extraordinary circumstances must be considered.

The following parameters will be considered for requests to transfer out of the district. Requests that do not meet the district's definition of emergency or extraordinary circumstance will be denied.

1. McKinney-Vento Act

Students who qualify as homeless under the federal McKinney-Vento Act.

2. Noninterruption of Program

Juniors or seniors who have attended the school as a freshman and sophomore.

3. Unusual Needs

Students with unusual academic needs that cannot be reasonably met by the district.

4. Extraordinary Circumstances

Students with significant and extraordinary circumstances that are addressed by an interdistrict transfer.

5. Extenuating Circumstances

Other extenuating circumstances as approved by the superintendent.

The Interdistrict transfer review committee at each school will review and evaluate interdistrict transfer requests and recommend approval or denial based on the above parameters. The committee will submit their recommendation to the superintendent on the attached form. Final determination will be made by the superintendent.

If the transfer request is denied, parents have the right to appeal the decision to the Board at its next regularly scheduled Board meeting. The decision of the Board is final.
