

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

This Memorandum of Agreement is entered into by and between the Board of Education on behalf of the Rogue River School District 35 (District) and the Rogue River Association of Classified Employees (Association).

The District and Association have identified a need for a stipend to be paid to members who volunteer to clean up students, who are not Life Skills students, after they soil themselves. The parties agree that when a student soils themselves, the students' parents will first be called. If the parents cannot be reached, or if they are unable to report to the school within a reasonable timeframe, the District and Association agree to the following:


- 1) By September 30, 2022, members may notify the RRES Principal that they volunteer to clean up students, who are not part of the Life Skills program, who have soiled themselves.
- 2) Starting on October 3, 2022, member volunteers will be assigned to this duty on a weekly basis and will be expected to fulfill this duty for a full week at a time. If more than one member volunteers, they will be assigned to this duty on a weekly rotating basis. For example, one member volunteer will be assigned for the week of October 3-7 and if there is more than one volunteer, another member volunteer will be assigned for the week of October 10-14, and so on.
- 3) Members will be paid \$5 per day in which they complete this duty. Members will document this on their time cards in the extra duty column as a toileting duty.
